

## LAYOUT NUMBER 1

### **LABEL DRILLING – PIN 1.30 – CG CENTER OF GRIP**

This is the most common of all drilling layouts, suitable for most bowlers other than low spinners.

In a 3-piece ball with a pancake weight block, the pin placement is not important, as it is not the center of the weight block. The weights in this drilling are zero and should promote a medium length and medium reaction in the backend.

In a ball with a center heavy weight block, the location of the pin is more significant, creating a medium to high flare, with a good backend reaction depending on release and lane condition.

Diagram is for a RH bowler, for LH bowlers place the pin in the 10.30 position.
